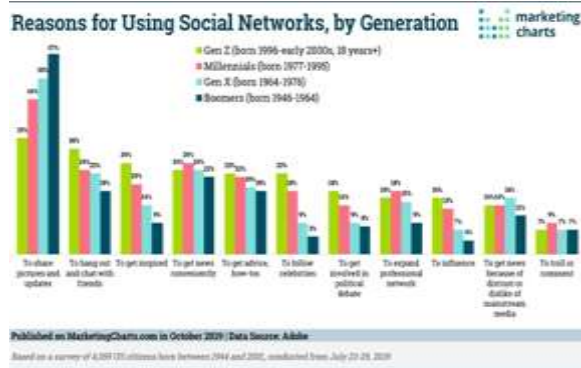


Fig 2: Reasons for using social networks, by generation

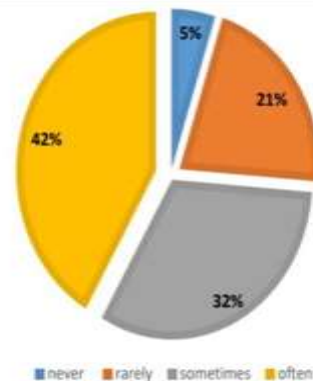


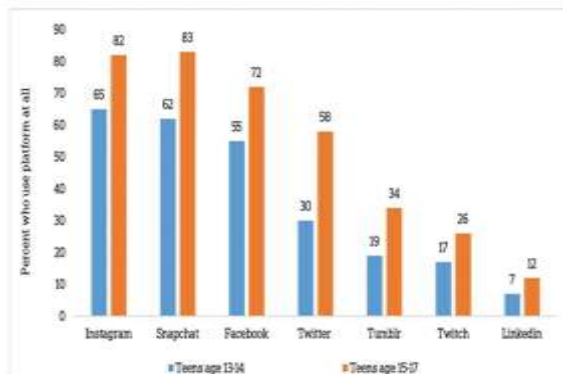
Fig 4: Perceived impact of social media on student’s social life
