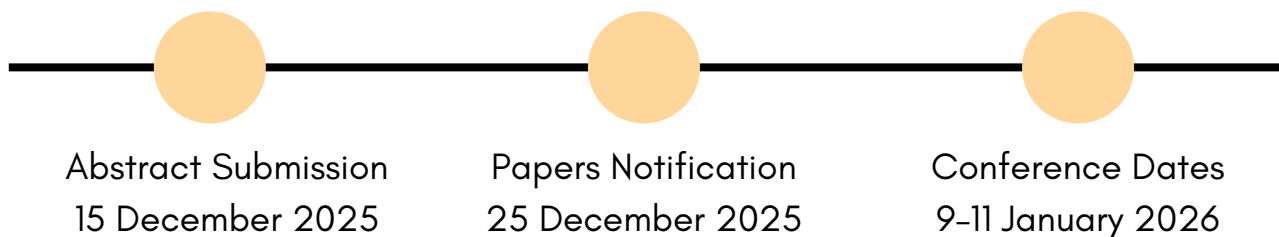
Requirements:
