Guidelines for Submission



- Submission must be in the MS-Word format.
- Font Guidelines: Times New Roman 12 font, 1.5-line spacing, and margins of one inch on all sides. Submissions in Hindi and Gujarati should follow standard and approved fonts as per academic and publication norms.
- The manuscript/typescript should include four major sections: Title, Abstract, Main body and references
- Maximum number of authors per paper can be four. All authors are required to register individually
- Abstract: 250–300 words
- Each research paper must contain an abstract with 4-6 keywords
- Full Paper: 3,000–5,000 words in MLA 9th Edition and APA 7th Edition format
- The paper must highlight specific research problem and adhere to appropriate research methodology
- Number of pages must not exceed 12 pages (including references)
- Tables must be converted into excel
- Figures must be 300 DPI

Publication Note: All papers selected after peer review will be published in the official conference proceedings. The publication fee applicable to the selected papers, if any, will be communicated to the respective authors at a later stage.


