Submission Guidelines

- Each submission must be accompanied by a cover page containing:
 - Title of the paper
 - Name(s) of the author(s)
 - Institutional affiliation(s)
 - Country of residence
 - Complete postal address
 - E-mail address and contact number of the corresponding author

- Manuscripts should be prepared in Microsoft Word format using:
 - Times New Roman, 12-point font
 - 1.5 line spacing
 - 1-inch margins on all sides
 - APA 7th Edition referencing style
- The full paper should not exceed 4000-6000 words and should include:
 - Title
 - Abstract and Keywords
 - Introduction
 - Objectives of the Study
 - Methodology
 - Findings and Discussion
 - Conclusion/Implications/Recommendations
 - References
 - Appendices (if applicable)

1. Abstracts should be between 250 and 300 words and must not exceed 300 words. Accepted abstracts will be published in the Conference Abstract Proceedings.
2. The conference follows a strict anti-plagiarism policy. Authors must ensure the originality of their work. All submissions will undergo a peer-review process.
3. The decision of the Review Committee regarding acceptance of papers shall be final.
4. Selected papers will be considered for publication in the Special Edition Volume with an ISBN/ ISSN, and will be published in an international peer-reviewed and Referred Journal, subject to review and compliance with publication guidelines.
5. Best Paper Presentation Awards will be presented for outstanding research contribution and Presentation.
6. All registered paper presenters and participants will receive an e-certificate of presentation/participation and paper Publication.
