

# Enabling Life-Long Learning Through Development of 21<sup>st</sup> Century Skills

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**Abstract:** There is a great need of identifying the significance of the developments that are taking place in new technological era by the young minds which are existing in the society at a faster growing rate. Equipping the young minds with skills and competencies updating are very much necessary in the forthcoming days, which enables all age-group learners to accept and get adapted to the upcoming expectations of life and place of work in the 21<sup>st</sup> century. Hence, there is a great demand for preparing learners to be the life-long learners through Education by developing the skills of 21<sup>st</sup> century such as Digital Literacy, Effective Communication, Collaboration, Critical thinking, Problem-solving, Decision-making and Creativity. The present study aims at exploring some 21<sup>st</sup> century skills frameworks which have identified and analyzed significant factors which would support learning to be life-long process. The participants of this study include 46 Pre-service teachers (MEd students) from Department of Education, BUB. To collect the data, tool administered was the questionnaire developed by Jan Oliver de Leon, University of Makati. The data obtained was analyzed descriptively and inferentially by calculating Percentage. The results conclude that there are significant differences in the Life-long learning of learners in relation to Sex, Medium of Instruction & Stream of specialization. The researcher suggests that various pedagogies can be considered and compared to know its contribution in the development, attainment of mastery of skills & competencies of 21<sup>st</sup> century which could include Problem-based learning, Flipped classroom, Serious games, Self-directed learning, Collaborative learning & Personalized learning.

## INTRODUCTION

Life-long learning can be defined as “all learning activities undertaken by a person throughout knowledge, skills and competencies within a personal, civic, social and employment-related perspectives.

As we all know that the new technologies are coming to the market at a faster growing speed which leads to the technological changes of our world, there is an urgent need to improve population’s skills, knowledge and competencies continuously. Therefore, it is very much necessary to be Life-long learners in order to develop ourselves, be up-to-date and also to sharpen our skills.

Education will be provided in the form of learning activities as follows-

Formal learning - the activities which takes place within an organized context,

Non-formal learning – the learning process that takes place within a set of activities that are not explicitly designated as learning,

Informal learning – learning that occurs during daily life activities i.e., learning from own experience.

Therefore, Life-long learning includes acquiring and expanding skills, behaviors and knowledge throughout the life of an individual which is a continuous learning process.

The Assessment and teaching of 21<sup>st</sup> century skills project develops a framework consisting of a hierarchy of skills that play a pivotal role in collaborative problem-solving. Due to the role of technology in the workplace and lifestyles, new skills were needed as well as new emphases on older skills.

Teaching approaches that support Life-long learning and 21<sup>st</sup> Century skills include-

1. 1.Problem – based learning – Is a pedagogy in which students learn by solving real-world or open-ended problems.
2. 2.Flipped Classroom – Short video lectures are viewed by students at home before class session, class-time devoted to exercises/projects/discussions.
3. 3.Serious games – Have an explicit & carefully through-out educational purpose, not intended to be played for amusement.
4. 4.Self-directed learning – promotes creativity & innovation where the learner learns him/herself with/without other's help.
5. 5.Computer supported Collaborative learning – examines how to use technology as a scaffolding tool to support collaboration and higher order thinking.
6. 6.Personalized learning- where learners can approach problems in their own way and at their own pace.

#### NEED & SIGNIFICANCE OF THE STUDY

The term Life-long learning is been used in learning or in the field of Education since more than 25 years, but has become more significant in 21<sup>st</sup> century because of the increased life expectancy & increase in the retirement age of workers. Due to the rapid changes in technologies and global needs, the expectations from the employees have also been changed.

Therefore, in order to succeed in getting a job, it is very much necessary to be a person ready to learn new ideas-regardless of age and should realize that Education should not be stopped when graduated.

The Life-long learning not only increases job prospects and supplements professional competencies, also helps in keeping the mind sharp which improves memory, enhancing self-esteem, helping one to adapt to changes happening in society, helping to make new friends, as there will be meeting new people during the learning activities.

In order to become a Life-long learner, a person should develop 21<sup>st</sup> century skills which includes digital literacy, communication, critical thinking, problem-solving, collaboration, creativity & imagination, which enables the learners to identify the learning activities which he/she has to undertake which in-turn improves knowledge & skills.

Few people also argue that the learners cannot develop 21<sup>st</sup> century competencies and skills, unless they are explicitly taught. Therefore, there is a great demand /need for formal education to transform, which enables new forms of learning and acquisition of competencies and skills through the applicability of new pedagogy methods. Some pedagogy methods are also more successful than others which helps students in developing 21<sup>st</sup> century skills.

This paper explores 21<sup>st</sup> century skills framework which identifies various skills which are important for the 21<sup>st</sup> century which also supports Life-long learning. 21<sup>st</sup> Century pedagogies must aim at employing innovative & research-supported teaching strategies, learning technologies, real-world applications which may contribute to the development and mastery of 21<sup>st</sup> century competencies and skills.

STATEMENT OF HYPOTHESES

1.There is no significant impact of 21<sup>st</sup> century skills on Life-long learning of pre-service teachers.

2.There is no significant difference between the Life-long learning through 21<sup>st</sup> century skills of male and female pre-service teachers.

3.There is no significant difference between the Life-long learning through 21<sup>st</sup> century skills of Kannada and English medium pre-service teachers.

4.There is no significant difference between the Life-long learning through 21<sup>st</sup> century skills of Arts, Science & Commerce pre-service teachers.

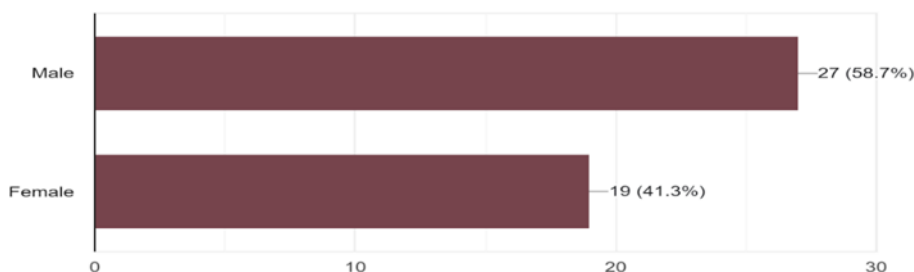
METHODOLOGY :

ANALYSIS & INTERPRETATION OF DATA

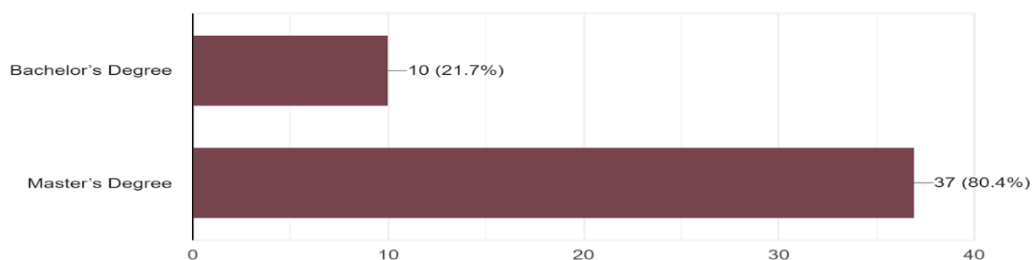
Section I : Demographic Information of Pre-service teachers :

46 responses



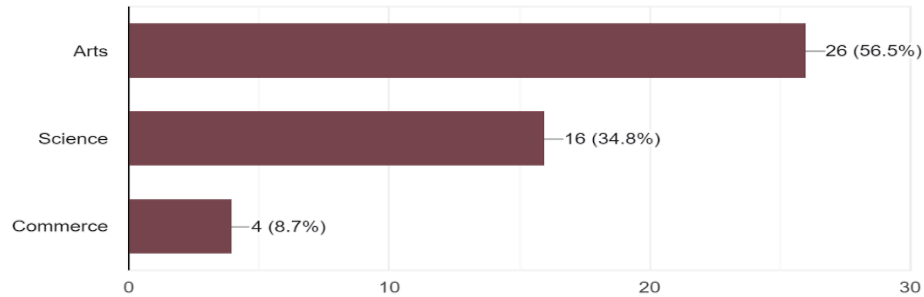
Out of 46 pre-service teachers considered for the present study, 58.7% (27) were male and 41.3%(19) were Female pre-service teachers.

46 responses

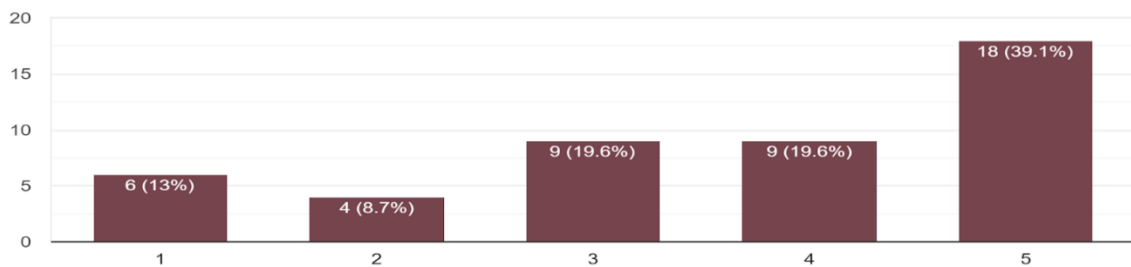

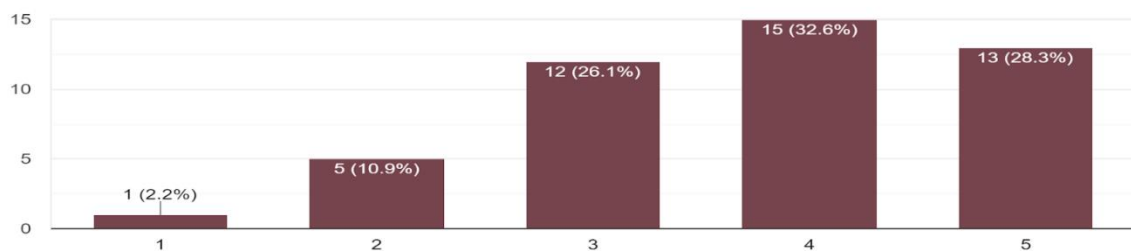

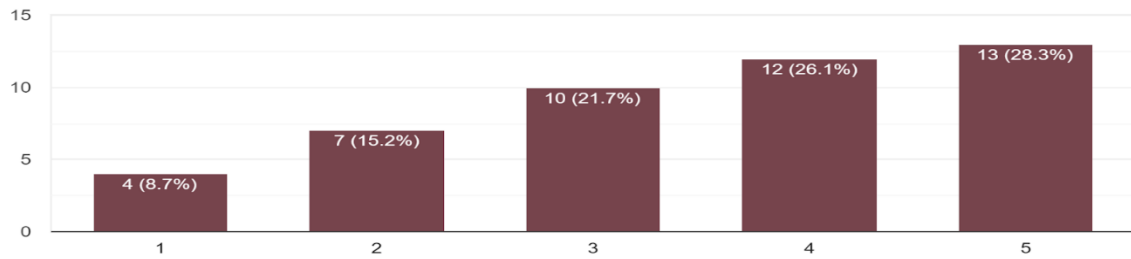

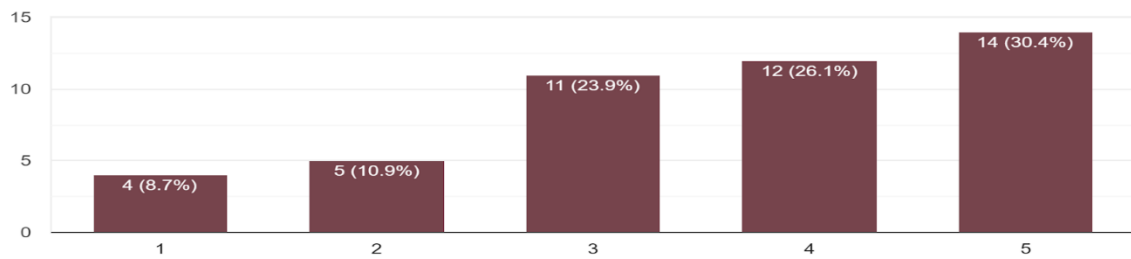

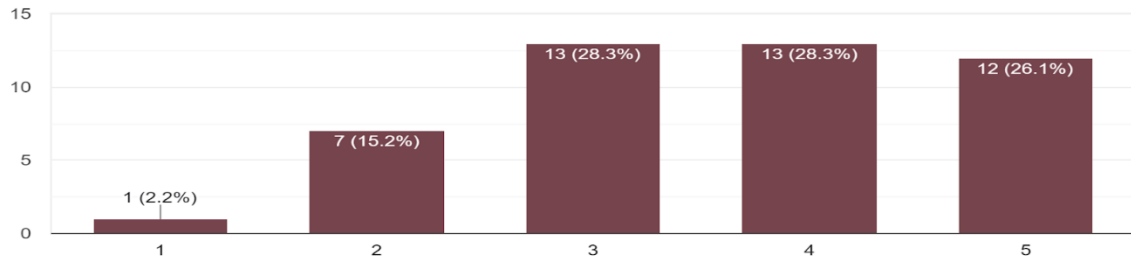

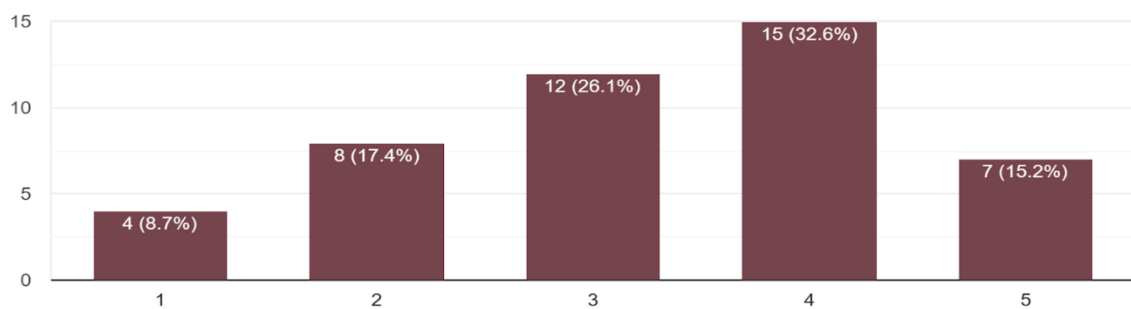

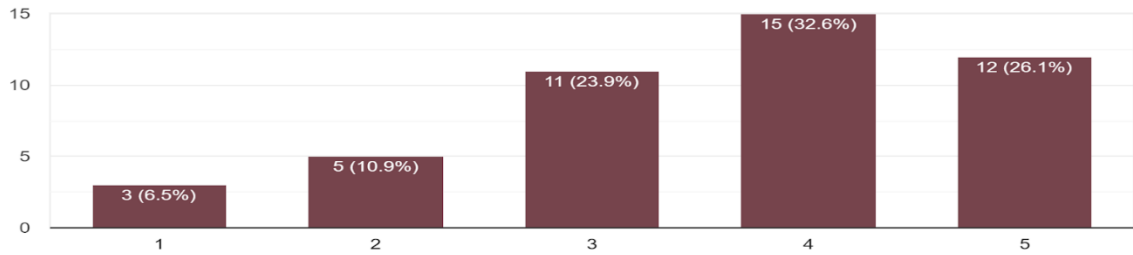

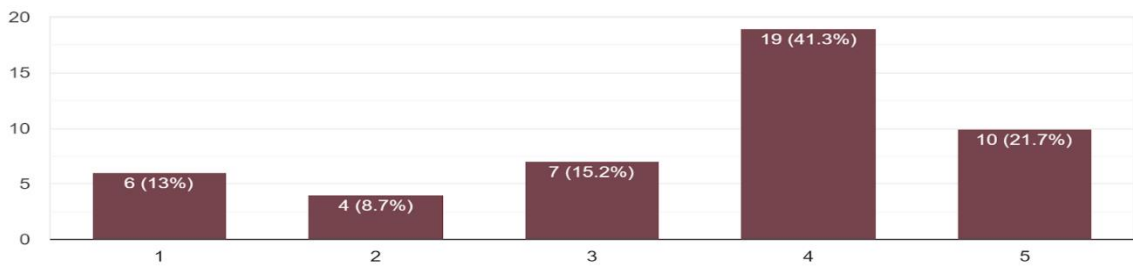

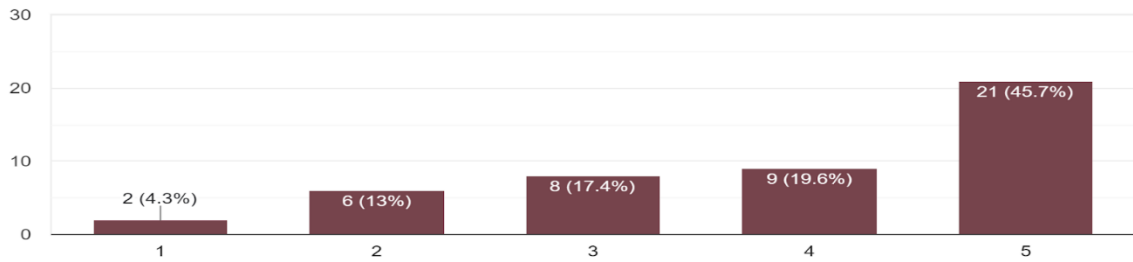

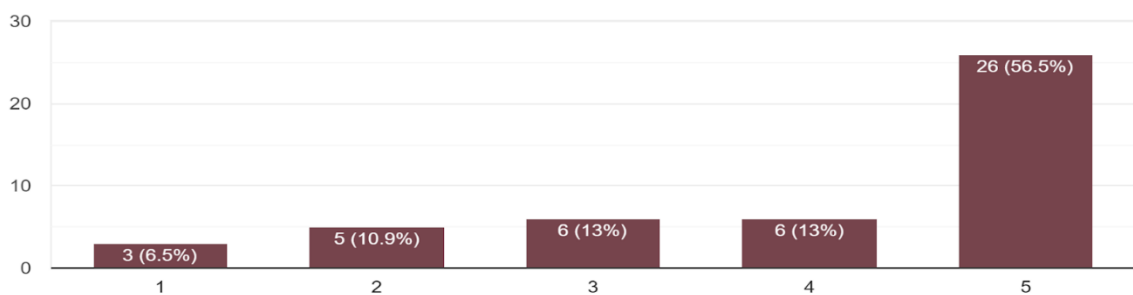

5. Critical thinking- Students always think of solutions rather than problems, evaluate evidences that support an argument before making a decision, use follow-up questions that focus/broaden inquiry.
6. Self direction- Students always set self-objectives & goals, actively involve in continuing professional development activities regularly, responsible for professional growth & development.
7. Collaboration & Team work- Always, they share leadership, know when to lead & when to follow, address challenges in the team through discussion & consensus-building activities, assist others to improve the team's overall performance.
8. Interpersonal Skills- They are always comfortable in providing constructive feedback, maintaining good relationship with all members of the team.
9. Interactive communication- They always ask probing questions that lead to greater understanding & concerns promptly, know how to listen actively.
10. Flexibility- Always and often, they effectively perform task as a pre-service teacher and other extra-curricular assignments, handle millennial and new generation well, accept that there are things need to be adapted.
11. Productivity- They always know managing time effectively for everyday activities, submit reports on time, maintain work-life balance.
12. Social & Cross-cultural skills- They always compliment others, accepts responsibility to own behavior, respects individual differences.
13. These are the skills(21<sup>st</sup> Century skills), the students need to develop in order to thrive in today's and tomorrow's dynamic workplace, increase their ability to work cross-culturally, and be able to take on positions of leadership.
14. 21<sup>st</sup> Century skills are the tools that can be universally applied to enhance ways of thinking, learning, working and living in the world.
