The pressure of the fetus in the abdomen, as well as hormonal changes, causes the haemorrhoidal vessels to enlarge. These vessels are also placed under severe pressure during childbirth.

piles have become a very common problem of modern era because of irregular life style, consumption of unhealthy food and lack of physical exercise. Its ratio has increased in the last few years, understand the disease, its impact and controlling are need of hours. Timely administered homoeopathic medicines take care of acute and chronic piles gently, effectively and without producing any side effects.

Hemorrhoid disease is the fourth leading outpatient gastrointestinal diagnosis, accounting for ~3.3 million ambulatory care visits in the United States. Self-reported incidence of hemorrhoids in the United States is 10 million per year, corresponding to 4.4% of the population. Both genders report peak incidence from age 45 to 65 years. Notably, Caucasians are affected more frequently than African Americans, and higher socioeconomic status is associated with increased prevalence. Contributing factors for increased incidence of symptomatic hemorrhoids include conditions that elevate intra- abdominal pressure such as pregnancy and straining, or those that weaken supporting tissue. Homeopathy stand the most popular among alternative medicines. Homeopathy, according to its principle "let likes be cured by likes" treats patients with a remedy that, in a healthy human, causes similar symptoms. 


