


Figure 2: Help Line Number.

**Call Resolution:** There will be a process for resolving calls in an effective and timely manner. The process will see to it that women get the support and assistance they require.




Figure 3: View and post blogs.




Figure 4: To-do List.

**Data Reporting:** Reports will be created based on data analysis. The reports will be utilized to enhance the platform and make it more effective.




Figure 4: Database Connectivity.


##### 6. Police Station Database and Response
