These products are typically made using solid wood, engineered wood, plywood, and sometimes metal or mixed materials. Product information received the highest rating of 4.3 due to clear descriptions and details, whereas performance and loading speed scored 3.8, mainly because of minor delays on mobile devices. The checkout process was rated 4.1 for its simplicity. Overall, 85% of users expressed willingness to revisit the website and 80% said they would recommend it to others, reflecting a positive user experience.




Fig 5.1 Data Flow Diagram





Fig 5.2 server side Activity




Fig.5.4.Class Diagram

The admin keeps track of furniture stock levels and updates inventory after each transaction to avoid overbooking or stock shortages.




Fig.5.5. Use case Diagram
