- **AI-Assisted Rotoscoping:** Isolating subjects from backgrounds—once a frame-by-frame nightmare—is now achieved with "magic mask" tools that track objects with incredible precision.
- **Upscaling and De-noising:** AI can take lower-resolution renders and upscale them to 4K or 8K while removing grain, drastically reducing the
